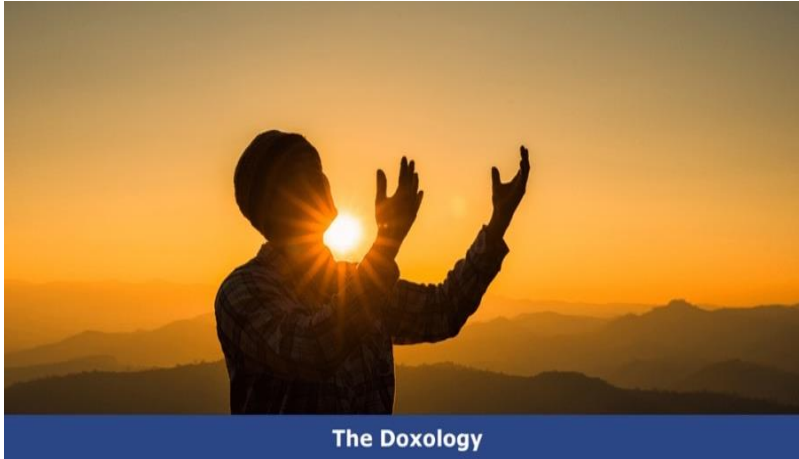

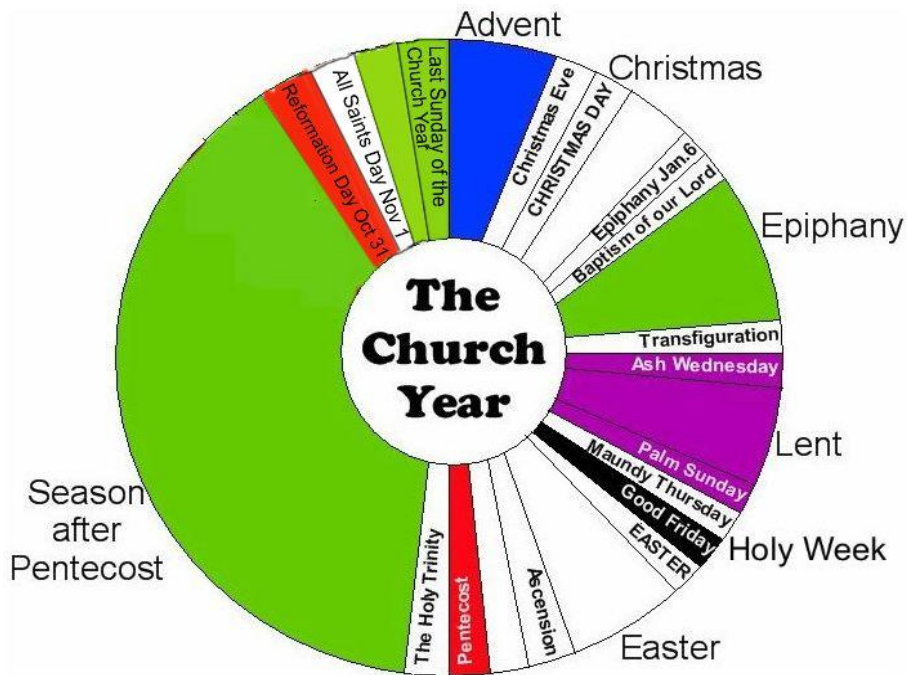
What's new in Sunday school?

Beginning in January, our Sunday school lessons will, for the most part, follow the lectionary, so our children will likely be studying one of the same lessons adults are hearing in the church service.

We are continuing to practice the Lord's prayer with them, with accompanying motions, and we will begin teaching the Doxology, similarly using motions to help them understand and memorize the hymn.



We will also continue to teach about the liturgical calendar and the significance of the various colors of the church seasons.



Our Sunday school offering through May will be sent to the Ronald McDonald house, a charity established to provide temporary homes for families whose children are hospitalized in Charlottesville for serious illness or injury, to ease the burdens and stresses on these families.
