The Men of Saint James is a Christian Fellowship Ministry of Saint James Episcopal Church in Louisa, Virginia. Established over 30 years ago, **The Men** partake in a monthly breakfast 8 times a year to enjoy Christian fellowship and comradery in a spiritual and casual atmosphere. The breakfasts are held at 8 am on the second Saturday of the month during March thru June, and September thru December. On several occasions throughout the year, **The Men** have a Guest Speaker on topics that are of interest and relevant to our Community.

The Men also sponsor several special events at Saint James throughout the year. These events include the Shove Tuesday Pancake Supper, Ladies / Mother's Day breakfast, a Baseball Game Fellowship outing, the Fall Festival / White Elephant sale in October, yard clean-up days at the Church, and special work projects for maintenance and repair of Church buildings.

Our primary mission is to foster and encourage Christian Fellowship both within our Congregation and within our Community. We "Reach Out" to our Louisa Community in several ways, including financial contributions to several local charities throughout the year. On occasion and when the need arises, **The Men** also participate in Community projects sponsored by other Churches or organizations to help a family or organization in need.

The Men maintain an e-mail list of **The Men** in Saint James and make periodic announcements about our upcoming breakfasts and other events throughout the year to keep all of **The Men** informed of what **The Men** are doing at Saint James.
