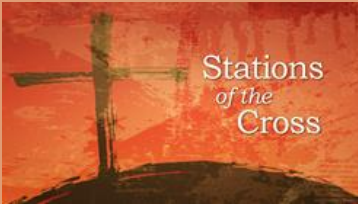

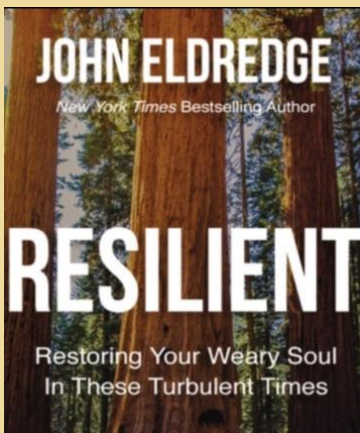


Stations of the Cross
