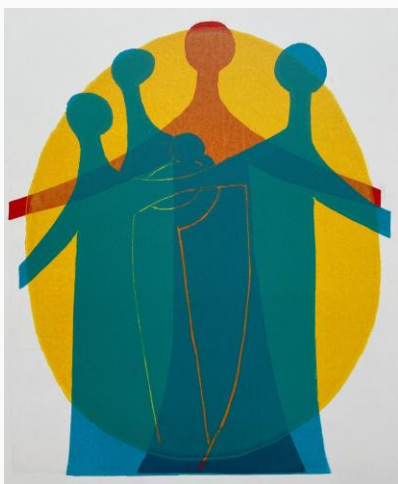
September 25 - 5-7 pm -- The Daily Prayers of the Church

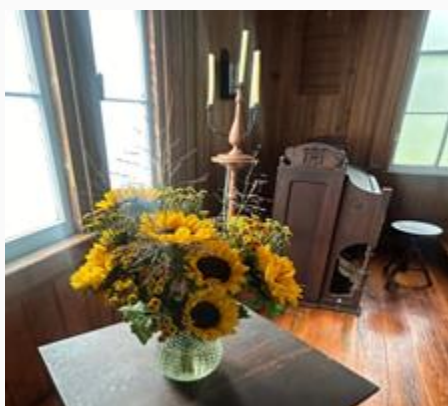
